## **Artspeak Gallery COVID-19 Safety Plan: For Visitors**

In accordance with [provincial mandates](#) and the recommendations of [WorkSafeBC](#), and for the safety of our staff, volunteers, community members, and visitors, Artspeak's regular operations have adjusted to the COVID-19 pandemic in the following ways:

### **Maximum Capacity**

Note: max capacity numbers may be reduced if the city's overall rate of COVID-19 transmissions rapidly increases; if changes occur, a revised maximum capacity will be posted to the front door of the gallery.

#### Gallery

A maximum of 15 people—including gallery staff, contractors and volunteers—may be present inside the gallery simultaneously. Class visits larger than this maximum will be encouraged to split their class into smaller groups; if this is not possible, teachers are asked to contact gallery staff to discuss alternative compromises.

#### Office

A maximum of 4 people—including gallery staff, contractors and volunteers—may be present in the office simultaneously.

### **Face Masks**

Face masks are mandatory at Artspeak. If visitors do not have their own mask, one will be provided to them.

### **Sanitation and Air Circulation**

Hand sanitizer and/or a handwashing sink will be available to all gallery visitors. Door knobs and surfaces that staff, contractors and visitors may touch regularly will be sanitized between visits. As weather allows, Artspeak will keep doors open to allow for better air circulation.
